We are a social innovation and futures agency that sits under the mana of Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu. Our role will be to design tools, manage partners, deliver wānanga, and evaluate and continue to improve the kaupapa.

Our goal is to empower you and other rangatahi to create the kaupapa that will shape the positive change we all want to see.

Te Wānaka Uruora is a kaupapa designed to support you—our rangatahi, the future generation—with the tools and skills to shape a better world. Who better to build the future than those who will inherit it?

Tokona te Raki, are looking for rangatahi who are passionate about making a difference. If you're driven to create positive change for future generations and are ready to collaborate with others to turn that vision into reality, this kaupapa is for you.

WHAT IS IT?

This new kaupapa offers the potential to learn some new skills designed to help you think more creatively, critically, and collaboratively to design the future you envision. We believe that by equipping you with these tools, you'll gain the confidence to shape a future where your collective dreams and vision can thrive.

WHO IS IT FOR?

We believe rangatahi are the next generation of changemakers, and we're committed to supporting you in developing the skills to lead transformative change now and into the future.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

We will teach you some tools and skills, then guide you as you define challenges you care about. Imagine the future you want and design the kaupapa (projects) to bring that future to life. By the end you'll feel empowered with the tools, skills, and confidence to drive transformative change for the future.



THE RANGATAHI JOURNEY:

Throughout this process, we will work with you to:

1. Discover what kind of future - maker you are.
2. Identify a kaupapa you're passionate about.
3. Explore how you can collaborate with other rangatahi Ngāi Tahu to create the change you want to see.

To support you, we'll provide tools to help you think creatively, critically, and collaboratively. These tools will sharpen your ability to:

- Understand the broader landscape (of your kaupapa).
- Explore your kaupapa in depth.
- Envision a new future.
- Take action to create change.



THE COMMITMENT:

We ask that you engage in the kaupapa, test the tools on a kaupapa you care about, provide feedback to improve them for future rangatahi, and complete regular wellbeing surveys throughout the process.

We expect a year-long commitment, with regular wānanga (about four per year) where we'll teach you these tools and support you in applying them to your kaupapa.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU?

By the end of this journey, you'll have:

- Tools to drive the change you want to see.
- Access to resources that help bring your vision to life.
- Ongoing support to keep your kaupapa moving forward.
- Attend noho with fellow whanaunga.

Depending on the progress of the rōpū, we may explore extending the timeline to further develop your kaupapa.
